



Directive No (3) for the year 2021

regarding the collection of definitive antidumping duties imposed on Imports of ceramic and porcelain tiles originating in or exported from China and India

- With reference to the Ministerial Directive No (1) for the year 2020 regarding the imposition of definitive antidumping duties on imports of Ceramic Flags and Paving, Hearth, Floor, or Wall Tiles; Whether or Not on a Backing; Finishing Ceramics (Ceramic and Porcelain Tiles) originating in or exported from China and India, since 06 June 2020 for a period of 5 years,
- And inconformity with the mechanism that has been agreed between the Ministry of Economy and the Federal Customs Authority as well as the Customs Directorates concerning the collection of definitive duties imposed on imports of ceramic and porcelain tiles originating in or exported from China and India,

Decides the following:

First: The payment of the final antidumping duty shall be made at the customs Directorate and before the customs clearance by applying the individual dumping rate for the concerned company as per the duties stipulated in the Ministerial Directive No (1) for the year 2020 and in accordance with the mechanism by which the Customs Directorate operates, as follows:

1. The company shall make the payment of the antidumping duty normally through the electronic or Manuel clearance system in force by the Customs Directorate, OR,
2. The company shall make the payment of the antidumping duty through the declaration and undertaking format concerning the calculation and payment of the anti-dumping duty on imports of ceramic & porcelain tiles originating in or exported from India and China, which shall be attached to the customs documents during the customs clearance proceedings.

Second: The payment of the antidumping duty through the declaration and undertaking format concerning the calculation and payment of the anti-dumping duty on imports of ceramic & porcelain tiles originating in or exported from India and China shall come into effect on 01st July 2021 and in doing so the company shall fill out the declaration and undertaking format electronically or a print copy as per the rules applied by the concerned directorate of customs.



Third: All economic operators and concerned Governmental Authorities are respectfully requested to comply with the provisions of this directive and to ensure its implementation accordingly from its date of issuance.
